Selection

Expressions of interest will be shortlisted by a sub-committee of the Editorial panel of artsandhealth.ie against the following criteria:

- High quality arts and health practice (see <http://www.artsandhealth.ie/about/what-is-arts-and-health> for artsandhealth.ie's description of arts and health)
- Demonstration of clear artistic vision, goals and outcomes
- Illustration of benefits for those involved
- Delivered by professional artists
- Availability of strong documentation

We aim to reflect a diversity of artforms, healthcare contexts and geographic spread in the case study section of artsandhealth.ie. Although the website promotes arts and health practice in the Republic of Ireland, up to three case studies from outside of the Republic of Ireland will be published per year with an emphasis on projects / programmes that do not have a counterpart in the Republic.

Shortlisted submissions will be invited to write a detailed case study based on a given template which may be edited by artsandhealth.ie.

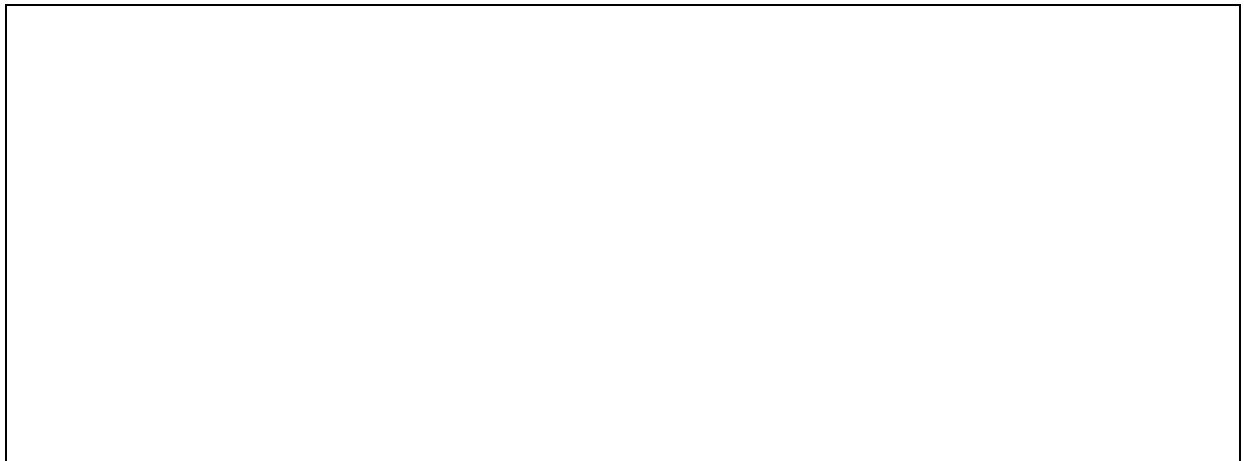
